Membership costs are unchanged from last year: \$90 for a single full membership and \$170 for a full family membership. Full memberships are required for anyone participating in any water events – i.e. clinics or tournaments. Full memberships include Waterski Wakeboard BC (WSWBC) memberships and with this, you receive reduced rates on boat insurance (<u>https://www.waypoint.ca/personal-</u><u>3/wakeski/</u>).
